Course Description

Writing can be lonely, and motivating yourself to write, a challenge. Writing with others, and protecting time to write, can increase productivity and make writing more enjoyable. We meet on Wednesday mornings to set specific writing goals for the day, then meet again at 16.30 to share how our writing has gone that day. The idea is to inspire and support each other to keep writing. You can also book a short 1-2-1 between 10am and 11am to discuss general or specific writing problems. **Please note: this group is most suitable for Year 2 and Year 3 researchers who are writing consistently over the six week period and can commit to turn up every week.**

All sessions run by Anne Wilson and Katie Grant are highly interactive. Numbers are limited, with every participant expected to do all required preparation, log-on on time, and contribute actively to the whole session. Writing Retreats require commitment to all the retreat days (2 days for Y1 and Y2; 3 days for Y3), and Writing Group requires commitment for six consecutive weeks. If you sign up and then have to cancel, you must let LISS know immediately. If you don't, you'll be depriving another researcher of the training opportunity.
